



WEEE requirements for European Union and United Kingdom customers

Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) contains materials, components and substances that may be hazardous and present a risk to human health and the environment when Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) is not handled correctly. Therefore, end users also have a role to play in ensuring that WEEE is reused and recycled safely. Users of electrical and electronic equipment must not discard WEEE together with other wastes. Equipment marked with the crossed-out wheeled bin is electrical and electronic equipment. The crossed-out wheeled bin symbol indicates that waste electrical and electronic equipment should not be discarded together with unseparated waste but must be collected separately. End users of BUNN equipment are required to properly dispose of BUNN equipment and accessories. By accepting these terms, you are accepting full responsibility of the safe disposal of WEEE in accordance with the WEEE regulations.
